PREPOSITIONS

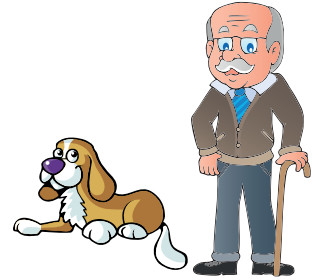
A preposition comes before a noun or a pronoun.
