

## **VOCABULARY (AFFIXES, PREFIXES & SUFFIXES)**

Affix: An affix may be a letter or group of letters added to the beginning or end of a word. Affixes change the meaning of root words and help in the formation of new words. Affix may either serve as prefix or suffixes.

Example: <u>Displease</u>, Helpful

<u>Prefix:</u> It is a letter or group of letters added to the beginning of a word to get a new word with different meaning.

Example: <u>Un</u> + happy = <u>Un</u>happy

Suffix: It is a letter or group of letters added to the end of a word to change the word into a

different word with new meaning.

**Example:** Care + <u>less</u> = Care<u>less</u>
