PRONOUNS

Personal pronouns refer to specific persons or things. They stand for three persons.

<u>First person:</u> person or persons speaking. <u>Second person:</u> person or persons spoken to. <u>Third person:</u> person / thing / persons / things spoken of.

A personal pronouns used must have the same number, gender and person as the noun it stands for. Personal pronouns may be used as subject / object in a sentence.

Example: I, We, He, She, It, They etc... are use of as subjects Me, Us, Him, Her, Them etc... are used as objects.
