APOSTROPHE (POSSESSIVE NOUNS)

i) My sisters birthday has been celebrated grandly.



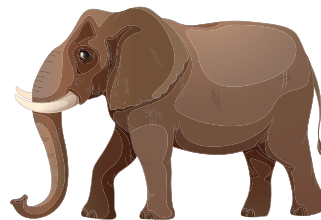
Answer: My sister's birthday has been celebrated grandly.

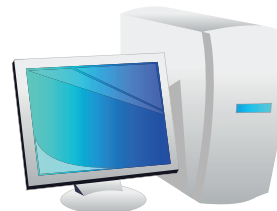
