SENTENCES & FRAGMENT (MAKE SENTENCES)

Sentence: A sentence is a group of words arranged in a sequence that conveys a complete idea. It consists of a subject and a predicate and expresses a complete meaning. Use complete sentences, when you speak or write.

Examples: 1) Lara plays cricket.
2) She is a graceful dancer.

Fragment: A fragment is an incomplete sentence where in a subject or predicate or other important group of words are missing. It does not express complete thought. It is a piece of sentence with a group of words wrongly / irregularly punctuated. Never use fragments when you write.

Examples: 1) Played base ball yesterday.
2) She sing a
