PAST TENSE OF IRREGULAR VERBS (USE THE IRREGULAR PAST VERBS AND MATCH)

Some verbs form their past tense in irregular way. They can't form their past tense in a simple / regular way. They don't follow the conventional rule of adding – ed at the end to form past tense.
