- » It is used to separate a quotation or an introductory element of the sentence.
- » It is used to separate the name of a city from the state or country.
- » It is used to separate day / date, month and year.
- » It is used after salutation words in a letter like.
 My dear brother, Dear friend,
- » My sweet darling, Dear Mr. James, Dear sir.
- » It is used after closing remarks of a letter such as. Regards, Thank you, love, lovingly, sincerely, faithfully, truly etc....
- » It is used after words like Yes, No, Well, Firstly, However, of course and before words like please.
- » It is used to indicate the omission of a verb to separate modifiers.
