SPELLINGS (PLURALS & VERB FORMS)

Most of the plurals end with -s, -es and -ies. There are some irregular plurals.

Examples: Key --- Keys, Leaf --- Leaves, Baby --- Babies,
Woman --- women, Tooth --- Teeth.

The past and participle forms of some verbs usually end with -ed / t

Examples: Walk --- Walked, Burn --- Burnt.

Progressive form of verb has -ing form.

Examples: Write --- Writing, Play --- Playing.

Irregular verbs have different past and participle forms.

Examples: Take --- Took --- Taken, Eat --- Ate --- Eaten.

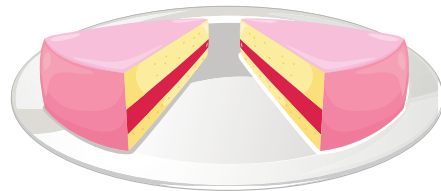
