## PROBLEM SOLVING QUESTIONS

Understand the following given data and then solve the problems.

## Example:

Alex has 14 pencils. He gives all of his pencils to his two friends. Each friend gets the same amount of pencils. How many pencils did each friend get? Explain your thinking using pictures, number or words.

## Solution:

- Alex, gave 14 pencils to his two friends.
- Each friend got the same amount of pencils.

1) Rahim has 12 biscuits. He gives all of his biscuits to his three friends. Each friend gets the same amount of biscuits. How many biscuits did each friend get? Explain your thinking using pictures, numbers or words.

## Solution:

- Rahim, gave 12 biscuits to his three friends.
- Each friend got the same amount of biscuits.

Since 12 is an even number we can represent the objects (biscuits) by making three rows equally.
