## USE OF DETERMINERS

Determiners come before nouns. They modify nouns and show how the nouns are being used.

A determiner clarifies what a noun is referring to.

**Demonstrative determiners:** This, that, these and those are called demonstrative determiners. This and that are used with singular nouns. These and those are used with plural nouns.

a). This camera is mine.



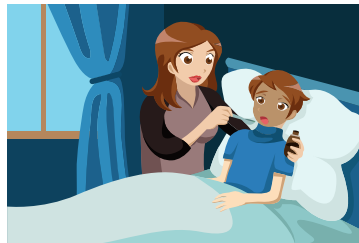
