USE OF 'BE' FORM VERBS IN PAST TENSE

A verb in past tense refers to past time.

1. 'Was' is singular verb form used with 'I', 'He', 'She' and 'It' in the past tense.
2. 'Were' is plural verb used with 'We', 'You' and 'They' in the past tense.

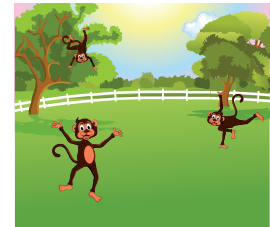
