Three quarters are shown on the left. To the right of an equals sign, there are three nickels, one penny, and one quarter.

4)

Two quarters are shown on the left. To the right of an equals sign, there are five nickels and one quarter.

5)

Two quarters are shown on the left. To the right of an equals sign, there are six nickels, one penny, and one quarter.
