

Make a ten to add with in 20.

1) Matthew made 9 paper boats and 7 paper rockets. Nicholas made 7 boats and 6 rockets with paper. How many paper toys Matthew made?

a) How many paper toys Matthew made?




$$\therefore 9 + 7 = \underline{\quad}$$

$$7 + \underline{\quad} = 10$$

$$10 + 6 = \underline{\quad}$$

Matthew made paper toys.

b) How many paper toys Nicholas made?



$$\therefore 7 + 6 = \underline{\quad}$$


$$6 + \underline{\quad} = 10$$

$$10 + 3 = \underline{\quad}$$

Nicholas made paper toys.

2) Ashlyn has 8 barbie dolls and 6 princess dolls. Alexia has 9 barbie dolls and 9 princess dolls.

a) How many dolls Ashlyn have?




$$\therefore 8 + 6 = \underline{\quad}$$

$$8 + 2 = 10$$

$$10 + \underline{\quad} = \underline{\quad}$$

Ashlyn has dolls.

b) How many dolls Alexia have?



$$\therefore 9 + 9 = \underline{\quad}$$

$$9 + \underline{\quad} = 10$$

$$10 + 8 = \underline{\quad}$$

Alexia has dolls.
