



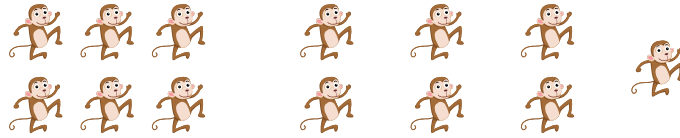

1. There are 6 monkeys inside the cage and 7 monkeys out side. How many monkeys are there?

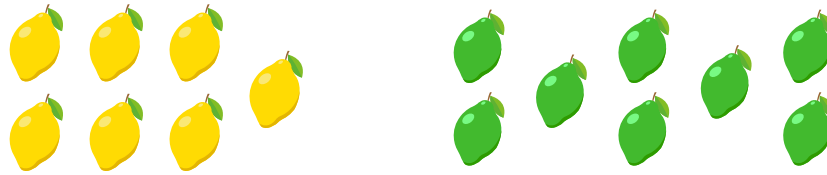
