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
SUBTRACTIONS

Solve the following by using the count on or take from strategy ten and tick (\checkmark) on the strategy you used.

Example:

a) Bill have 13 dollars. He spent 9 dollars. How many dollars Bill have?

$$13 - 9 = 4$$



$$10 - 9 = 1$$

$$1 + 3 = 4$$

Take from ten.

Count on.

1) There are 18 parrots on the tree. 9 parrots fly away. How many parrots are there on the tree?

Take from ten.

Count on.

2) Dora has 14 bananas. She gave 9 bananas to her mother. How many bananas Dora is left with?
