SUBTRACTIONS

Solve the problems by counting on and using a number bond to take from ten.

1. In the ground, 10 monkeys are playing on the tree and 2 monkeys are sleeping under the tree. 9 of the playing monkeys leave the ground. How many monkeys are left in the ground.

$$12 - 9 = \underline{\quad}$$

$$\begin{array}{r} 12 \\ \diagdown \quad \diagup \\ 10 \quad 2 \end{array} - 9 = \underline{\quad}$$

There are monkeys left.

2. Bill have 16 muffins on his plate. He ate 9 of them. How many muffins are left in his plate.

$$16 - 9 = \underline{\quad}$$

$$\begin{array}{r} 16 \\ \diagdown \quad \diagup \\ 10 \quad 6 \end{array} - 9 = \underline{\quad}$$

Bill have left with muffins.

3. Mike has 14 car toys with him. He gave 9 car toys to his brother. How many car toys Mike have.

$$14 - 9 = \underline{\quad}$$

$$\begin{array}{r} 14 \\ \diagdown \quad \diagup \\ 10 \quad 4 \end{array} - 9 = \underline{\quad}$$

Mike has car toys left.
