- 2) Harry, Tom and Dick are good friends.



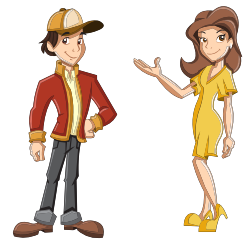
- 3) Our company has offices in Washington, New York and Las angles.
