



ADDITION OR SUBTRACTION

Questions on reasoning and thinking.

Example:

Jessica's lemon tree has 526 lemons. She gave away 300 lemons. How many does she have left? Use the arrow way to solve.

Solution:

Jessica's lemon tree has <u>526</u> lemons.

She gave away <u>300</u> lemons.

 $526 \xrightarrow{-100} \underline{426} \xrightarrow{-100} \underline{326} \xrightarrow{-100} \underline{226}$

Number of lemons that Jessica have left <u>226</u>.
