299

H	T	O

1) 12

H	T	O
0	1	2

$$\underline{\quad} + 2 = 12$$

4) 124

$$100 + 20 + 4 = \underline{\quad}$$

2) 104

H	T	O
1	0	4

$$100 + \underline{\quad} = 104$$

5) 215

H	T	O
2	1	5

$$100 + \underline{\quad} + \underline{\quad} = 215$$

3) 324

H	T	O
3	2	4

$$300 + \underline{\quad} + 4 = 324$$
